3. All pupils must be residents of Schoharie County or attendants of schools located in Schoharie County during the school year.
4. Articles exhibited must have been made during the year preceding this exhibition.
5. No specimen exhibited previously will be considered.
6. In judging, age will be taken into consideration if the exhibit is accompanied by a label giving the age of the exhibitor.
7. Exhibits **MUST** be removed between 11:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on Sunday after the Fair or they will become the property of the Fair.
8. Merit ribbons will be awarded to all school entries.
9. Suggestions are welcome for children's classes. A suggestion box will be available to help us plan for next year's classes. Please feel free to give us your ideas.
10. Age and grade **MUST** be included on entry blank.
11. Entries for Department 12 with entry tags attached will be accepted in the Country Living Building on **Sunday July 24 between 2:00 pm and 7:00 pm and Monday July 25 between 2:00 pm and 7:00 pm.** Entries for **Section 9, Culinary and Section 8 Flowers only**, with entry tags attached will be accepted in the Country Living Building on **Wednesday July 27 between 2:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. NO LATE ENTRIES THIS YEAR.**
12. Minimum age for entries is 4.
13. **Since there is no charge to enter Department 12, entry does not entitle exhibitors to purchase a Youth Exhibitor Ticket.**
