General Rules and Regulations

1. Before making entries read "Standards of Conduct of Fairs" and "Livestock Requirements".
2. Before making entries read "Rules and Regulations" pertaining to goats.
3. Exhibits must be put in place by 2:00 p.m. Tuesday, August 2. Exhibitors will be allowed to leave the grounds on Sunday, August 7, 2010, after 8 a.m. Exhibitors leaving before 8:00 a.m. on Sunday will forfeit their premium money. Livestock exhibits will not be accepted before noon on Tuesday, August 2.
4. Age of all animals in this department will be computed from date of birth to the day of show.
5. Each exhibitor will supply his/her own feed and bedding. Limited pens are available on a first come, first served basis. Exhibitors are responsible for clean up of their area.
6. Not over two premiums shall be awarded to any one exhibitor in any one class. Ribbons shall be awarded as judged.
7. All animals shown in group or special classes must have been shown in their regular age or category class.
8. Check of entries, classes and registration papers will occur before the show starts.
9. Please indicate on entry form the total number of animals entered for exhibition in this department.
10. All goats must have a permanent form of identification that coincides with both veterinarian inspection certificate and registration papers (if applicable).
11. All females that show must have kidded at least once since turning 24 months of age.

REGISTERED DAIRY GOATS

2011 DAIRY GOAT SHOW WILL BE SANCTIONED BY THE ADGA

Dairy Goat Rules and Regulations (in addition to General Rules & Regulations):

12. All animals will be ADGA, AGS or CGS registered and have their registration/recordation paperwork. If under 6 months of age, a stamped duplicate of the registration application is acceptable. Additionally, tattoos must be legible, and correlate with the registration paperwork. **All dairy goats must be unloaded and in place by 7:00 AM. Pens will be available on a first come-first serve basis.**
13. There will be no pre-show milkout. Overly distended udders will be discriminated against.
14. Exhibitors are encouraged to enroll their milking does in the Official ADGA sanctioned One-Day Milk Test Competition on Friday and Saturday.
15. Milk is to be disposed of in area noted by the superintendent.
16. **NO HORNS** on dairy animals.
17. No refunds after entries close; substitutions are allowed with breed section at no extra fee.
18. Vehicles and trailers will be allowed in the area for loading and unloading only, they must be parked in designated areas during the show.
19. Judging is scheduled for 9:00 A.M. on Saturday for dairy goats in the Sheep Barn. All Dairy Goats must be unloaded and in place by 7:00 A.M. Pens will be available on a first come – first served basis.
20. **PLEASE NOTE: Goats entering for the one day show only will pay \$5.00 per class if entered prior to deadline; OR \$10.00 PER CLASS IF ENTERED DAY OF SHOW.**

Official One-Day Test Dairy Goat Milking Competition – ADGA Sanctioned

This test allows does to get their ADGA "star milker" designation. This competition is open to any goat registered or recorded in ADGA, AGS or CGS. Registration papers and freshening dates are required. The goats planning to participate in the Test must be on the premises Tuesday, August 2 by 2:00 p.m. Milk production will be measured for a 24 hour period. The first milk out will be Tuesday, August 2nd beginning at 7:00 p.m. The test day will be Wednesday, August 3rd at 7:00 a.m. and at 7:00 p.m. Any goat that receives 18 or more points will be awarded an automatic *M designation. Points shall be given for quantity of milk, for period of time since last kidding, and for butterfat as follows:

- a. For each pound of milk, one point figured to one decimal place.
- b. For each complete ten days the goat has been in milk since last kidding, one tenth (.1) of a point with a maximum of 3.6 points.
- c. For each .05 pounds of butterfat yielded in the milkings, one point

Meat, Fiber and Performance Goat Rules & Regulations (in addition to General Rules & Regulations):

12. Horns are allowed, no discrimination for dehorned animals.
13. No bucks will be shown, including the meat classes.
14. All animals in sections 46, 48, 49 & 50 will be registered and have their registration paperwork. If under 6 months of age, a stamped duplicate of the registration application is acceptable. These animals must be tattooed, Scrapie tagged or microchipped (bring your own reader) according to the official USDA Scrapie program guidelines. Animals in Section 47 must be properly identified according to the USDA Scrapie program guidelines (tag).
15. Senior animals must have kidded at least once.
15. Market goats can only show in market classes; they are ineligible to show as breeding stock.
16. No refunds after entries close; substitutions are allowed within breed section at no extra fee.
16. Vehicles and trailers will be allowed in the area for loading and unloading only, they must be parked in designated areas.
16. Judging is scheduled for noon on Friday for Meat, Fiber and Performance Goats in the Sheep Barn.
17. **PLEASE NOTE: Goats entering for the one day show only will pay \$5.00 per class if entered prior to deadline; OR \$10.00 PER CLASS IF ENTERED DAY OF SHOW.**
